INVITATION TO BIDDERS

UNITED IRRIGATION DISTRICT is accepting sealed bid proposals to construct the Taylor Road Phase II, Bus 83 to Mile 2, Irrigation Pipeline Relocation and supply of line gates and alfalfa valves.

SEALED PROPOSALS addressed to Mr. Jesus Garcia, President, at the office of United Irrigation District, of Hidalgo County, 1006 W Mile 2 Rd, Mission, Texas, 78574, will be received until Wednesday, September 9, 2026, at 11:00 AM, for furnishing materials, supplies, and labor necessary for the construction of Taylor Road Phase II, Bus 83 to Mile 2, Irrigation Pipeline Relocation, in accordance with the specifications on file at District Office. At the time stated, bids will be publicly opened and read at the District Office. A Pre-Bid conference will be held Wednesday, September 2, 2026, at 11:00 AM, at the office of United Irrigation District 1006 W Mile 2 Rd, Mission, Texas, 78574.

PLANS may be examined without charge at the District Office or at the office of Ferris, Flinn & Medina, LLC, 1405 N. Stuart Place Rd., Harlingen, Texas, 78552.

Complete Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents may be obtained, upon request, from Ferris, Flinn & Medina, LLC, by calling (956) 364-2236. The cost is \$150.00 per printed set and/or \$75.00 per electronic set. All document fees are non-refundable.

Documents are not pre-printed. Bidders requesting a printed set should contact the office in advance to allow sufficient time for printing prior to picking up.

Each bidder is responsible for ensuring that they are included on the Bidders List maintained by Ferris, Flinn & Medina, LLC.

A CERTIFIED OR CASHIER'S CHECK, or an acceptable bid bond in an amount not less than five (5) percent of the total bid shall accompany each bid as a guaranty that, if awarded the Contract, the bidder will promptly enter into each contract with United Irrigation District and furnish bonds on the forms provided.

BIDDERS are expected to inspect the site of the work and to inform themselves of all local conditions. All work shall be completed within one hundred twenty (120) calendar days after receipt of Notice to Proceed.

United Irrigation District reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any or all informalities, and to award the contract to the bidder or bidders, who, in the opinion of the **District** offers the proposal in its best interest. The prices submitted will be unit prices and the award will be based on the estimated quantity of work outlined in the bid form considering the work the Owner will actually perform. **The work includes material, labor and equipment necessary to construct approximately 418 feet of new relocated irrigation pipeline, including earthwork, fittings, gates, valves, standpipes, outlet assemblies, concrete collars, connections, existing irrigation facilities removal, backfill, excavation, bore using Bentonite, casings, and any other incidentals necessary for a complete and operable system in Mission and McAllen, Texas. The material supply package will include a bid for line gates and alfalfa valves.**

BIDDERS are cautioned that conditional or qualified bids, or bids not in the proper form may be rejected.
